

Dial-A-Ride

Quick Facts

- ◆ Apply for Eligibility
- ◆ If eligible, receive your Dial-A-Ride card by mail
- ◆ Find out about the Dial-A-Ride service area to learn if you will be able to use this transportation service for your destinations
- ◆ Make an advance travel reservation by phone
- ◆ Be ready up to 60 min before your pick-up times
- ◆ Tickets may be purchased at the Best Friend Express office or from your driver.

Miscellaneous Items:

Pets are not allowed on the bus except for service animals; which may include more than a seeing eye dog.

Drivers are NOT allowed to enter homes or offices. If you require further assistance, please apply for Personal Care Attendant eligibility where you can bring an escort with you to assist with mobility needs. This approved escort would ride for free.

Seatbelts must be worn.

Have the street address of your destination ready when you call to schedule a trip.

Please tell us if you will be requiring a vehicle lift for your scheduled trip.

Where can I travel?

Travel must take place within service areas. Service areas are 3/4 of a mile from the fixed bus routes of the Best Friend Express. You **MUST** be picked up and dropped off within a designated service area.

Examples of possible locations you could travel to/from:

- ⇒ Common shopping areas in both Aiken & North Augusta
- ⇒ Hospitals & doctor's offices
- ⇒ ATC & USC-Aiken Colleges
- ⇒ Some agencies like DSS/DMV/ Salvation Army/ACTS

Who is eligible to ride?

While anyone can catch a ride on the Best Friend Express, only persons with qualifying disabilities are able to make a reservation for pick up and drop off times with the Dial-A-Ride transportation program.

How do I get a Dial-A-Ride card?

Call the Lower Savannah Council of Governments ADTRC to request an application at **803-508-7033 Press #1**. A doctor must also sign your application to verify your disability before a decision can be made about your eligibility to ride.

Is there a fee to apply?

What kind of assistance can I expect?

The driver will assist with any wheelchair or vehicle lift needs you may have.

What are my responsibilities as a rider?

*Give 2 hours notice of a cancellation.
Purchase tickets from the Best Friend Express office or from your driver prior to transportation.*

Now that I have been approved for the program, how do I schedule a trip?



Reservations for DAR trips are received from 8:15 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday—Thursday and Friday 8:15 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. at 803-508-7033. Please leave a message on the voice mail if you are calling after hours or on weekends. You may also call the Dial-a-Ride dispatcher at the Aiken Area Council on Aging office at 803-648-6493. Reservations should be made no later than the day before your requested day of service.
